



Eastern Army National Guard Aviation Training Site (EAATS)

Mission

Located on Fort Indiantown Gap, adjacent to Muir Army Airfield, the Eastern Army National Guard Aviation Training Site's mission is to train Soldiers, pilots, aircrew and mechanics to operate and maintain utility and cargo aircraft including the UH-60 Black Hawk, CH-47 Chinook and the UH-72 Lakota. The training site administers a variety of courses supporting this goal, including aircraft qualification courses and maintenance courses. Additionally, the site manages flight simulators for regional users and in support of formal courses of instruction. The training site provides aero medical services in support of its mission.

Facilities

The Eastern Army National Guard Aviation Training Site operates the largest flight simulation complex in the reserve component. The training site consists of 35 acres, six instructional buildings, five transient training quarters, an aircrew dormitory, three full motion simulators, three transportable flight simulators (LUH-SFTS, BAT, TFPS), two cockpit procedural trainers (CH47-CPT, LUH-CPT+), one Nonrated Crew Member Manned Module, nine UH-60 Black Hawk and three CH-47 Chinook hardware maintenance trainers, five virtual interactive trainers and 14 CAPT Basic/1 CAPT-Enhanced/1 CAPT-EVCS for UH-60M training.
